38th Sports Day

Our school will hold the 38th Sports Day at Kowloon Bay Sports Ground on 4 December, 2024 (Wednesday) and 21 January, 2025 (Tuesday). Details of the event are as follows:

Event Dates	Preliminary: 4 December, 2024 (Wednesday) Final: 21 January, 2025 (Tuesday)
Event Time	8:00 am to 4:30 pm
Location	Kowloon Bay Sports Ground (Address: 1 Kai Lok Street, Kowloon Bay)
Remarks	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Students must wear their proper winter sports uniform to the sports ground and bring the necessary sports gear to participate in the competition. For details, please refer to the information posted on Google Classroom.2. Athletes should check the competition schedule and lanes before the event, follow the teachers' guidance, maintain discipline, and pay attention to safety.3. Students should bring enough water and some money on the Sports Day. There will be around 1 hour for lunch, during which they can eat at nearby eateries.4. The dismissal time for the Sports Day is tentatively set for 4:30 pm, but the actual time may be delayed. Students must wait until the Day's events or award ceremony are completed before leaving the sports ground.5. Reference: Location and directions to Kowloon Bay Sports Ground [open]
Arrangements under adverse weather conditions	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. If the Observatory issues a Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 8 or above, or a Red or Black Rainstorm Warning Signal before 8 am, and the Education Bureau announces that all schools in Hong Kong are closed, the Sports Day will be immediately cancelled, and students do not need to go to the sports ground or return to school.2. If the Observatory issues a Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 3 before 8 am, or if the general air quality health index in the Kowloon Bay area reaches a severe level (level "10+"), making it unsuitable to hold competitions, the Sports Day will also be cancelled. In this case, if the Education Bureau has not announced school closures, students must return to school for classes.3. If it rains on the day, and the Observatory issues a Tropical Cyclone Warning Signal No. 1 or a Yellow Rainstorm Warning Signal, students are still required to report to the sports ground. The school will decide based on the actual conditions whether the Sports Day and various competitions will continue.4. Parents are advised to remind students to pay attention to announcements from radio and television stations before departing, and to check the school website and eClass messages for the latest arrangements.

The Sports Day is a school day, and **all students must attend on time**. If a student is unable to attend due to illness or other reasons, they must follow the regular procedures to request leave from the school. Unexcused absences will be considered truancy. 5 December, 2024 (Thursday) will be a compensatory day off after the sports day, and students do not need to return to school on that day.
