Dear Parents,

Arrangements for Students Leaving School in Inclement Weather

1. To ensure our students' safety, the school has established a Typhoon and Rainstorm Response Committee to take care of the security of those who have returned to school during typhoons or heavy rainstorms.
2. Please pay attention to weather reports on radio/television at all times. If the Observatory issues tropical cyclone, thunderstorm, or heavy rainstorm warning signals, parents should be particularly concerned about the safety of their children during their journey to school.
3. When the Observatory issues a typhoon signal No.8 or above, or a red/black rainstorm warning signal, students do not need to return to school. Parents and students should pay attention to the weather reports on radio/television between 6 a.m. and 7 a.m., as well as the latest information announced by the Education Bureau.
4. If classes are suspended due to inclement weather as announced by the Education Bureau, all activities on that day, including classes, tests and exams, will be cancelled and rescheduled at a later date. However, tests and exams scheduled for the class resumption day will proceed according to the original timetable, and relevant information will be announced on the school website.
5. If a student returns to school during the effective period of a red/black rainstorm warning signal, the school will have staff members taking care of the students on campus and making appropriate arrangements for them to return home at an appropriate time.
6. During school hours, if the Education Bureau announces an immediate suspension of classes due to an approaching typhoon, the school will keep the students at school and arrange for them to return home gradually while ensuring their safety. If the Observatory issues a red/black rainstorm warning signal during class hours, the school will continue classes until the normal dismissal time and then arrange for students to go home, if the situation permits.
7. If parents wish the school to assist in taking care of their children in special situations such as tropical cyclones or continuous heavy rain until the parents come to the school to pick them up, please indicate your preference in the reply slip below.
